The actual inception of the San Buenaventura Women's Club was in 1920. It was reorganized and given its present name and was then affiliated with the Ventura County Federation of Women's Clubs and with the General Federation of Women's Clubs in 1949. In July of 1953, the club was incorporated into the California Federation of Women's Clubs.

In 1947 the San Buenaventura Women's Club organized the Junior Division and was their sponsor.
