

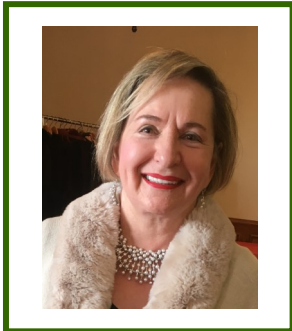

Dear Members,

Your Executive Board Members have been busy even though we have been unable to meet in person. We have had several Zoom meetings to deal with club matters. After seeing some emails from TAD, CFWC and GFWC it is apparent that here at SBWC we have our "house in order" so to speak as far as end of Club Year requirements are concerned.

Your Membership Secretary Barbara Marcus with the help of several others has provided our end of the year membership information together with payment of dues to TAD on time.

We have taken care of our election of officers for the coming year and sent out our annual donations. Our proposed slate of officers was unanimously approved by our membership with 25 electronic votes and 24 votes by paper ballot for a total of 49 votes.

We were unable to purchase the clothes for the children at City Center due to the "shelter in place" orders. Knowing that these families will be having an even more difficult time the Board decided that a cash gift now would be of most use. We are in the process of purchasing a \$40 gift card for each resident, adult or child, at City Center. We chose Target gift cards as they sell food, groceries and basic goods and there is a Target Store close to of City Center.

We are also in the process of sending a \$1,000 donation to Food Share.

We are keeping in touch with members by telephone and have reports that many enjoyable connections have been made.

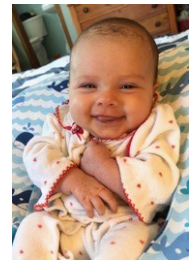

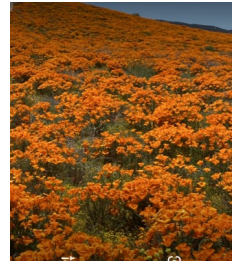
HOW I SPEND MY TIME IN QUARENTINE
