

Just want to let you know that had our April meeting not been canceled due to COVID-19, you would have had the opportunity to meet and greet some very special guests. Ventura Police Officers Ortega and Portillo, accompanied by their furry partners, K9 Miles and K9 Deco were scheduled to join us at that meeting but they certainly understood why that couldn't happen.

As you probably recall, the K9 Unit receives no funding and must rely entirely on community donations. At that meeting, we were going to present a donation of \$1200 for the purchase of training aides for K9 Miles, the explosive detecting dog. Not wanting to wait until we're able to safely meet again, towards the end of April, we mailed our donation to Sgt. Welch, the supervisor of Ventura PD's K9 Unit. A few days later, I received a lovely message that I'd like to share with you.

Sgt. Welch first thanked us for the donation of \$1200 for the training aides. He then noted that due to COVID-19, they will be canceling the annual Bark Out Loud event. The Sgt. explained that BOL is their biggest fundraiser and since it's canceled, they need all the funds they can get to keep their programs going. He wanted me to let everyone at S.B.W.C. know that they are "incredibly grateful" for our donation and our support. Sgt. Welch also wants you to know that once we're able to safely meet at the Pavilion, he promises to "make the meet and greet happen!"

So, thank you ladies for once again supporting the Ventura Police Department's K9 Unit. We can look forward to seeing Officer Ortega and K9 Miles and meeting the newest officer, K9 Deco and his handler, Officer Portillo. Until then, stay safe and stay well.
