Karen Campbell, a local realtor, routinely contacts **Move In** when she has clients that need to downsize their housing. Kathy Powell, Director, was most appreciative of ongoing donations by our Club Members. What they need most (and continually) are: can openers, twin and full sheet sets, kitchen utensils and towels.



So far, in 2024 alone, this group has assisted 55 households, made up of 123 people, including 14 veterans and 54 children.
